Walk In:

How do I fill out the registration form?

1. Please fill out YOUR name, address and phone number on the registration form.
2. In the boxes under the participant's name, put the names of the people participating in the class or going on the trip. Please put your name in here as well if you are going to attend the class or go on the trip.
3. In the last column, please indicate the cost of the trip. Also remember that non-residents (do not reside in Windsor Township or Windsor Borough) may participate; however, they must pay the non-resident fee.

Registration

- All programs have a minimum and a maximum level of participation and are available on a first come, first served basis.
- Programs may be cancelled due to insufficient registrations, inclement weather or other sufficient cause.
- Full payment is due upon registration and can be made payable to "WARC" by cash, check or money order. No space can be guaranteed until full payment is received.
- For a receipt, send a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- You will not receive notification or confirmation of a course or trip unless you check the box on the registration form indicating you wish to receive a reminder call.
- No tickets will be issued for bus trips; your name is placed on a list and you are to check in with the chaperone upon arrival that morning.
